1.0 Commitment to Achieving Net Zero


The move to Net Zero carbon emissions by 2050 is essential in order to mitigate global temperatures rising beyond 1.5°C, and to avoid the worst impacts of climate change.

In order to deliver against our core values, Central Group is committed to achieving Net Zero carbon emissions by 2050, associated with its 2021 baseline. Central Group will reduce its value chain emissions through a wide range of initiatives, such as implementing renewable energy sources and collaborating with our supply chain to reduce our scope 3 emissions, as far as reasonably possible.

For any unavoidable residual emissions, Central Group has pledged to invest in leading practice carbon removal techniques to tackle any final emissions from our footprint and the wider supply chain emissions, i.e. Carbon Offsets. Our ambitious targets are aligned with the Science Based Target Initiative (SBTi). Central Group is reporting its full greenhouse gas emission profile, which consists of our scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions following the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol, under the boundary of financial control.

1.1 Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 06/21

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21. This Carbon Reduction Plan includes emission data from Scope 1 and 2 of the GHG protocol and a defined subset of Scope 3 emissions, to ensure compliance to PPN 06/21.



2.0 Baseline Emissions Footprint

The organisational boundary of the carbon reduction plan includes Central Roofing and Building Services Ltd, and Central Roofing (South Wales) Ltd - Central Group, where there is financial control over carbon emissions.

Our Baseline emissions are a record of greenhouse gases produced by Central Group, prior to any introduction of direct carbon reduction strategies to reduce our emissions. The Baseline emissions provide a reference point which future emissions can be measured against. Central Group's baseline year is Jan-Dec 2021. The baseline carbon footprint includes Scope 1, Scope 2, and all relevant categories of Scope 3; Category 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 & 7.

The carbon footprint methodology is measured using the Greenhouse Gas Protocol and verified by an external consultant, Elemental Consulting Group.



Central Group Board of Directors

Additionally, the ESG Manager holds the responsibility of influencing individuals within the organisation to adopt a more sustainable outlook, provide awareness and support the Sustainability Committee. The ESG Manager contributes to integrating effective sustainability practices and methodologies into Central Group's core operations.

Central Group Sustainability Committee

The Sustainability Committee consists of members of the Central Group team who are responsible for the ownership and achievement of a carbon reduction target, playing a critical role in our overall carbon reduction. Serving as a formal communication channel, the Sustainability Committee will allow for ongoing support and awareness for the effective execution of the members' actions. Those tasked with implementing measures to meet the carbon reduction targets will receive specialist knowledge and guidance to ensure the effective implementation of the carbon reduction initiatives.

EV Charging Points

Central Group's ongoing commitment to invest in PHEV company vehicles has rapidly resulted in the installation of electric vehicle charging points at all owned branches, to facilitate the transition to an all-electric fleet.





Waste Management

Implementation of a waste reporting system to enhance the level of detail on the current treatment and disposal method for project site waste across the Group. The waste reporting system has enabled more accurate and consistent reporting of waste generated in Central Group's owned and controlled operations.





Scope 3 Emissions Identified

Central Group identified its Scope 3 emissions to begin measuring against the baseline and to determine the emission hotspots across its value chain. As Scope 3 emissions account for over 70% of Central Group's total emissions footprint, this highlights the significance of the group continuing to address its value chain emission hotspots in order to reach its overall target of Net Zero by 2050.



2023

CRBS obtained certification in ISO14001:2015 - now CRSW and CRBS now operate Environmental Management Systems under the ISO14001:2015 standard.

Scope 1, 2 & 3 emissions identified to create a baseline and current footprint to begin to develop our Carbon Reduction Plan.
